Age categories, field size

U8 boys born after 2019.01.01
U9 boys born after 2018.01.01.
Player Pool 10 players + 2 coaches.
Field type: grass and artificial grass
Field size: 50x30m
Goal size: 5x2m / Ball size: 4



Line-up, playing time

4 outfield players + 1 goalkeeper
Guaranteed 8 matches for each team.
Game time: 1x10 minutes
Guaranteed playing time: 120 minutes/ team
Guaranteed matches: 12



Prize

Each participant of the III. ÓBUDA Youth Cup will receive a unique certificate. All players will receive a gift given by the tournament sponsors!
1st - 3rd place: Cup + Medal
Top scorer: Trophy + Certificate + Gift
Best goalkeeper: Trophy + Certificate + Gift
Tournament MVP: Trophy + Certificate + Gift



Rules and regulations

Group matches:

2-2 groups of 8 teams / age group, round robin matches in each group

Points system of the tournament:

Victory - 3 points
Draw - 1 point
Defeat - 0 point

Ranking rule - deciding group positions:

- more points scored
- head to head
- goal difference
- more goals scored
- penalty kicks (3-3)

Play-off

After the group matches, the first 4 places will play in 2 new groups, after that they will decide the 1th-8th places by cross-matches. The 5th-8th places from the group will decide the 9th-16th places by the same process.

Refereeing

The matches will be officiated by 1 referee.
From the semi-finals (semi-finals, 3-4th place, finals) 2 referees will officiate the matches.

GOAL KICK, THROW-OUT

The goalkeeper may bring the ball into play only from the ground, when it leaves the baseline, but may not pass it directly into the opponent's area. The goalkeeper may not kick the ball out of his hand, even if it is already in play.

SIDE KICK, THROW-IN, CORNER KICK, FREE KICK

The ball leaving the touchline may be put into play by passing it flat-footed (under the knee). For a side kick or corner the opposing player must be at least 3 m away. For free kicks, the opposing player must be at least 5 m away.

HOME PASS

A ball passed home with the foot from a field player to his own goalkeeper must not be caught by the goalkeeper with his hand, if this occurs the opponent may take an indirect free kick.

SUBSTITUTION

Substitutions may be made at any time and the substituted player may be replaced.

Offside

There is no offside rule in the tournament.

Extra time

No extra time in the tournament!

PENALTY KICKS

Penalty kicks must be taken from 7 metres from the designated spot. If no other way of deciding the group placing between two teams is available, the order shall be decided by 3-3 penalty kicks. In the event of a draw in the play-offs (places 1-8), the match shall be decided by 3-3 penalty kicks. If the score is equal after 3-3 penalty kicks, the parties shall kick 1-1 more penalty kick until a decision is made. A penalty kick may be taken by any player who is on the Player List. A player who has already kicked a penalty once may only kick again if everyone else on the team has already kicked a penalty once in that sequence.

SUSPENSION

Yellow- and red card cautions are in effect for the tournament.

A yellow card warning will result in a 2-minute suspension, after which the suspended player may return to the field.

In the case of a red card warning, the suspended player shall not be allowed to play in the match and the following match and shall not be replaced for the remainder of the match.

Line-up, playing time

6 outfield players + 1 goalkeeper
Guaranteed 8 matches for each team.
Game time: 1x15 minutes
Guaranteed playing time: 120 minutes/ team

Rules and regulations

Group matches:

2-2 groups of 6 teams / age group, round robin matches in each group

Points system of the tournament:

Victory - 3 points
Draw - 1 point
Defeat - 0 point

Ranking rule - deciding group positions:

- more points scored
- head to head
- goal difference
- more goals scored
- penalty kicks (3-3)

Play-off

After the group matches, the first 8 places will be decided by cross-matches (A1-B4, A2-B3...) between the 1st 1-4 of the 2 groups. The 5-6 runners-up of the 2 groups will play for the 9th-12th places in a round-robin system.

Refereeing

The matches will be officiated by 1 referee.
From the semi-finals (semi-finals, 3-4th place, finals) 2 referees will officiate the matches.

GOAL KICK, THROW-OUT

The goalkeeper may bring the ball into play from the ground, from a set-piece or with his hands when it leaves the baseline, but may not pass it directly into the opponent's area.

The goalkeeper may not kick the ball out of his hand, even if it is already in play.

SIDE KICK, THROW-IN, CORNER KICK, FREE KICK

The ball leaving the touchline may be put into play by passing it flat-footed (under the knee) or by throwing it in. For a side kick, the opposing player must be at least 3 m away.

For corner kicks and free kicks, the opposing player must be at least 5 m away.

HOME PASS

A ball passed home with the foot from a field player to his own goalkeeper must not be caught by the goalkeeper with his hand, if this occurs the opponent may take an indirect free kick.

SUBSTITUTION

Substitutions may be made at any time and the substituted player may be replaced.

Offside

The general offside rule applies in the tournament.

Extra time

No extra time in the tournament!

PENALTY KICKS

Penalty kicks must be taken from 9 metres from the designated spot. If no other way of deciding the group placing between two teams is available, the order shall be decided by 3-3 penalty kicks. In the event of a draw in the play-offs (places 1-8), the match shall be decided by 3-3 penalty kicks. If the score is equal after 3-3 penalty kicks, the parties shall kick 1-1 more penalty kick until a decision is made. A penalty kick may be taken by any player who is on the Player List. A player who has already kicked a penalty once may only kick again if everyone else on the team has already kicked a penalty once in that sequence.

SUSPENSION

Yellow- and red card cautions are in effect for the tournament.
